We will equip participants with the knowledge to help their patrons create better dissemination strategies and inspire compelling impact statements. - Exploring social media platforms commonly used to disseminate research
- Writing plain language summaries of research
- Exploring tools that track alternative metrics
- Identifying institutional and open repositories, and the importance of archiving outputs
- Optimizing outputs for discoverability by search engines
- Crafting research impact statements
