Data News

Last October, Biosciences and Bioinformatics Librarian Pamela Shaw shared with the FSM community an update on the [Final NIH Policy for Data Management and Sharing](#). The policy states that beginning in 2023, all NIH proposals must include a two-page data management plan outlining how data and metadata will be managed and shared. Awardees are encouraged to use “established repositories” for sharing data, which can include the FSM institutional repository, [DigitalHub](#).
