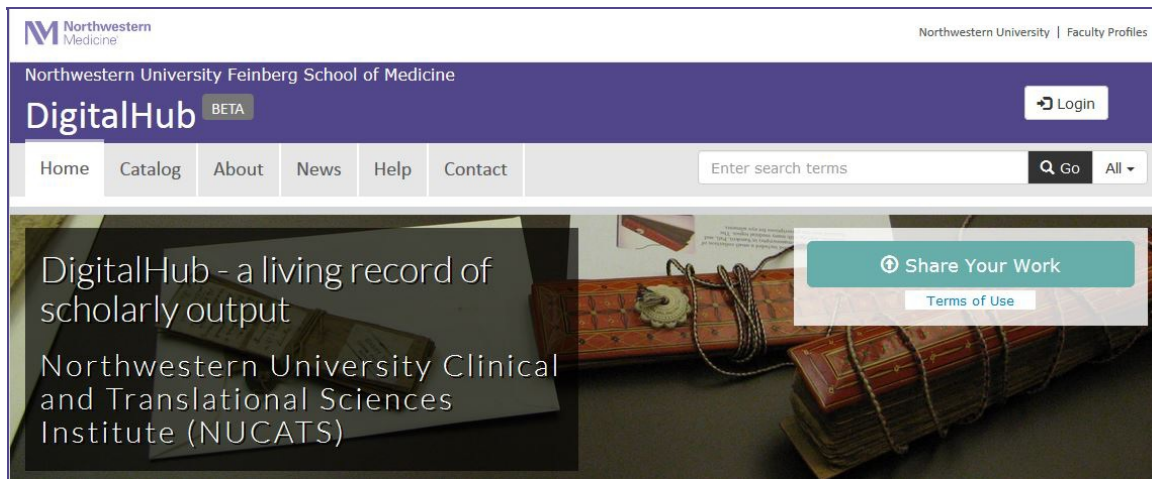


DigitalHub, Northwestern Medicine's Institutional Repository is Now Open

The Galter Health Sciences Library is pleased to announce the official debut of the institutional repository, DigitalHub. The repository debut has been scheduled to coincide with the international [Open Access Week](#) (October 19-23, 2015).

This institutional repository will provide open access to the scholarly outputs of Northwestern Medicine.
