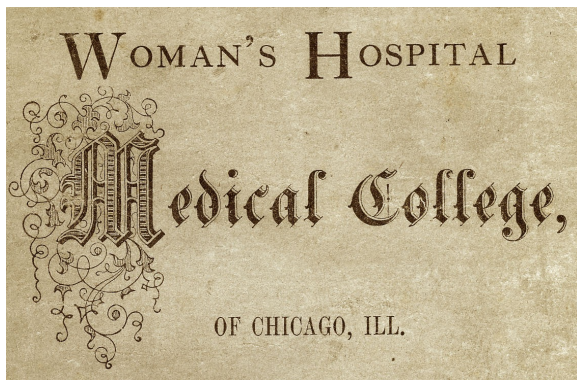


Exhibition Celebrating the History of the Woman's Medical School Now on Display
