

Endnote 21 for Mac and Windows Now Available

Endnote 21 for Windows and Mac is now available from NUIT at no charge to NU faculty, students, staff, and residents.

What's New in Endnote 21?

- Tagging feature: Organize your references using tags
- Access to the new Endnote Web interface
- Data restoration
 - Restore a lost or damaged library
 - Restore a previous version of a reference in your synced library
- Features with limited functionality or pending release (see "Known Issues" for details):
 - Synced library and group sharing with up to 1,000 colleagues
 - Cite While You Write for Google Docs

Known Issues

- The new Cite While You Write for Google Docs (an Endnote plug-in) has several limitations. Of note:
 - Reordering content within a Google Doc can break citations.
 - Footnote and superscript citation styles are not supported.
- Library and group sharing online is not yet available through the new [Endnote Web](#). Until this feature is released, teams who need to collaborate on a shared document should use a [traveling library](#).
