

New Research Integrity Tools Available to Feinberg Faculty and Staff: Proofig & iThenticate

Ensuring research integrity is essential to maintaining the highest standards of academic publishing. To support Feinberg researchers in this effort, faculty and staff now have access to two powerful tools: Proofig and iThenticate available through Galter Library. These resources help researchers identify potential issues before manuscript submission, reducing the risk of delays, corrections, or retractions.

Why These Tools Matter

Journals and publishers are increasingly vigilant about research integrity concerns, including plagiarism, improper citation, and image duplication. Many manuscripts undergo rigorous checks, and undetected issues can result in submission rejections, retractions, or damage to a researcher's reputation. By proactively using these tools, researchers can prevent unintentional errors, improve manuscript quality, and ensure compliance with publisher guidelines.

What These Tools Do

- **Proofig** helps detect image duplication and manipulation in scientific papers. It uses AI-powered analysis to identify potential issues in images, ensuring that all images meet the highest standards of transparency and accuracy. This versatile tool can analyze microscopy, Western blots, in-vivo and in-vitro images, among many others.
- **iThenticate** is a plagiarism and AI detection tool that compares a manuscript against a vast database of academic literature. It helps researchers verify originality, check for inadvertent text similarity, and ensure proper citation practices.



How Feinberg Researchers Can Benefit

We strongly encourage faculty to take the time to run their manuscripts through these tools before submitting to journals. Using Proofig and iThenticate can help researchers avoid unnecessary hurdles in the publication process and maintain the credibility of their work. Addressing potential concerns early on ensures smoother interactions with editors, reduces the risk of retractions, and upholds Feinberg's commitment to research integrity.
