| Description: | A presentation of two bibliometrics networks: Co-Author Network to highlight collaborations with key members of the group; and a Term Co-occurrence Network to highlight topical expertise within the group. An overview statement is provided for each network. This report can complement data in the Funding Support Impact Statements. |
| Purpose: | Bibliometric networks are useful in visualizing connections between people or publications. The co-author collaboration network highlights the strength of co-authorship between individual authors. The term co-occurrence network highlights keywords extracted from the title and abstract of publications to show topical expertise and trends in research topics. |
| Input Needed from Requestor: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calendar year range (if other than default of 5 most recent years) • Document Types for inclusion (if other than all types including articles, editorials, books, etc.) • Faculty names with NetIDs (preferably in Excel) |
